The Sustainable Business Unit (SBU) leads NKG Bloom, our group-wide sustainable sourcing strategy focusing on improving farmer livelihoods via holistic service packages, including financing, technical assistance, inputs and market access.

The Position

The Farmer Finance Program Manager position will be based in the Neumann Kaffee Gruppe headquarters in Hamburg, Germany. The main responsibility for this position is to support the NG Head of Sustainable Business in the overall implementation of the Smallholder Livelihoods Facility, including:

- ▶ Ramp-up/preparation work required to get each NKG company ready to meet all the requirements for borrowing from the Smallholder Livelihoods Facility (a financing facility with three global banks, that includes an innovative risk-sharing component)
- ▶ Supporting companies in preparing, and globally consolidating the quarterly reporting for the Facility stakeholders
- ▶ Coordinating with NG Finance on all cash-flow management aspects of the Facility

In addition, the Program Manager will provide support to the Head of the SBU, in certain topics related to NKG BLOOM, including:

- ▶ Providing support to import companies in understanding the NKG BLOOM concept, so that it can be best presented to customers
- ▶ Providing support to NKG companies that are in the process of obtaining and implementing grants for the set-up or strengthening of Smallholder Services Units
- ▶ Providing support to the Head of NG Sustainable Business for grant and/or partnerships applications towards the advancement of the NKG BLOOM concept, and liaising with these partners/donors when necessary

Needed Skills

- Fluent English, working level proficiency in Spanish, German and/or Portuguese desirable
- At least 5 years experience in project management and micro finance
- Excellent communication skills
- Minimum of Bachelor's Degree in Economics, Finance, Development or Agronomy.
