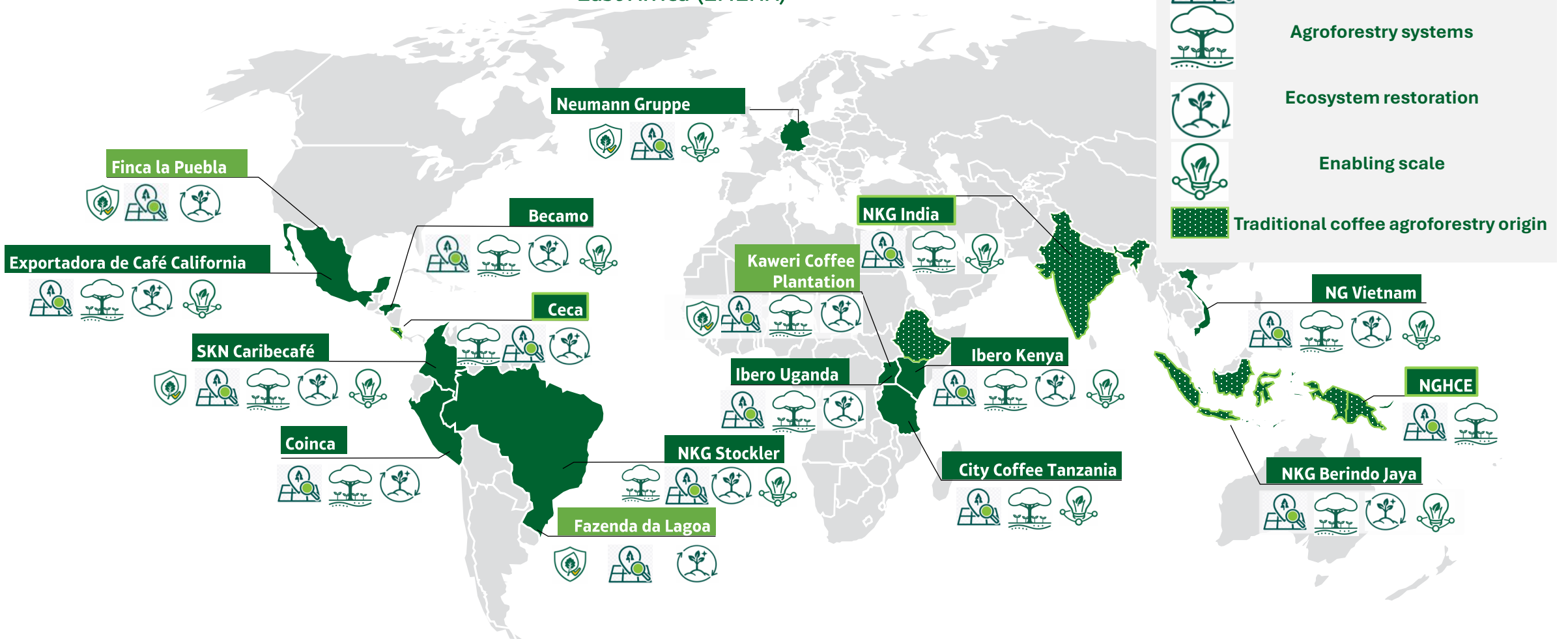

# Types of forest positive actions



## Legend

	<b>Committing &amp; safeguarding:</b> All commitments, safeguards and area- or governance-based mechanisms that prevent deforestation/conversion and protect forests & ecosystems
	<b>Forest monitoring &amp; tracing:</b> All systems that let us “know and prove” what’s happening on the ground — mapping, traceability, spatial screening and monitoring that underpin forest-related claims.
	<b>Agroforestry systems:</b> All production-system changes that integrate trees and improve on-farm ecological function — agroforestry plus regenerative agronomy that stabilizes yields on existing land and reduces pressure to expand into forests
	<b>Ecosystem restoration:</b> All active interventions that increase or recover tree cover / ecosystem integrity — restoration of degraded land, reforestation/afforestation, and tree planting
	<b>Enabling scale:</b> All enablers that make forest-positive action replicable such as pilots, research, partnerships, awareness-raising, and the documentation/structuring work that allows practices to spread across origins and companies

# Context



- **Coffee renovation at scale:** 43.6m seedlings produced since 2020
- **2025 was a standout:** 20.9 million coffee seedlings in one year alone – that means ~57,000 per day, ~2,400 per hour, and ~40 per minute
- **More than coffee plants:** 2.1 million forest seedlings and 95,739 crop trees for shade and diversity
- **Agroforestry at the heart of coffee culture:** Ethiopia, India, Costa Rica, Indonesia, PNG as traditional coffee agroforestry origins
- **Regenerative agriculture at scale:** 155,805 hectares under regenerative practices
- **A network of know-how and practice:** 86,341 producers trained on Regenerative Agriculture
- **17 nurseries, millions of seedlings:** a practical platform for agroforestry and climate change adaptation
- **Conservation and restoration that matter:** 4,829 ha restored or conserved with additional 43km of riparian buffer zones on our own farms – equating roughly 7,000 football pitches

Agroforestry	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 17 seedling nurseries</li> <li>• 43.6 million coffee seedlings produced in our nurseries during the past 5 years, of which 20.9 million in 2025 alone</li> <li>• 95,739 crop tree seedlings produced in our nurseries</li> <li>• 2.1 million other forest seedlings produced in our nurseries</li> <li>• In addition to systematic agroforestry approaches there are origins with traditional coffee agroforestry systems: Ethiopia, India, Costa Rica, Indonesia, PNG</li> </ul>
Regenerative agriculture	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 155,805 ha under regenerative agricultural practices</li> <li>• 86,341 producers trained on Regenerative Agriculture</li> <li>• 19 Regenerative Agriculture projects or programs in 8 countries</li> </ul>
